Steel sheet 20g one 12"x12" sheet
Powdered Rose Bronze powdered metal clay, 10g
Powdered Smart Bronze powdered metal clay, 10g
Powdered Brilliant Bronze powdered metal clay, 10g
Powdered White Satin powdered metal clay, 10g
White bronze powder, 20g
Copper powder, 20g
Fine silver powder, 5g
Stainless steel lab spoons
Condiment cups with lids

Shared supplies:

Gun bluing
Sealer Wax
Shofu wheels
Wool daubers

Note: Depending on availability of powdered metals, substitutions may be made.

Note: If you want to fuse gold powder to steel, you should bring to the workshop at least one inch of 14g round gold wire (any karat). You will use this to grind gold powder for fusing. As an alternative, you may choose to purchase the following: Powdered gold—one gram packet, Allcraft 800 645 7124 (Also available for purchase during class)
