

Materials kit for Remote Students-

Students can order gold powder ahead of time here:

and supply their own small, sable type paintbrush and ceramic type small bowl

One Gram of 24K Pure Gold Powder-375.00 (Gold Price Subject to Change)

Students will need a heat source, either a hotplate (typical dorm room style) or a beehive kiln. Larger pieces, like bracelets, may require the heat of a kiln, whereas smaller type earrings and pendants work well on the hotplate. The kiln can be purchased ahead of time here:

If students are planning on working on round as opposed to flat style pieces, they can purchase a titanium stand here:

Flat pieces can rest directly on the hotplate or kiln

- or hollow silver beads
- or silver sheet (either fine, Argentium or sterling silver, any thickness) for use with cold-connection attachments later

Please have jewelry studio basics available (just in case you find you need to finish up anything):

- Tweezers
- Shears
- 400 sandpaper

- Burnisher Agate or Steel
- Pliers
- dowels
- files
