If you have your own hand tools, files, sawframe, pliers, please bring them for your personal use. Please mark your tools to identify them as yours. Nail polish works for this.

I will have copper, brass and silver for sale to make your projects or you can provide your own.

For the ring:

A 3 x 3 inch piece of 18 or 16 sheet of brass, copper, or silver will work to make several rings.

For the chain with clasp:

Two to three feet of brass, copper, or silver round wire in 14 or 16 gauge

Purchase copper or brass from the instructor to make the ring and chain for \$10.
