## Studio-appropriate attire:

- Closed-toe shoes
- No loose/dangling clothing or accessories
- Hair tied back

## Basic Supplies:

- Pens & pencils
- Notebook & sketch paper
- Dust mask / N95

## Supplies:

The materials fee will cover what is needed to complete the project. It is recommended that you bring your own basic bench tools and finishing supplies, if you have them.

If you want extra practice, you can bring a square copper sheet that is around 18g to 20g and measures 3 to 6 inches in both directions. Silver is also a great option to work with but is much pricier.

It always helps to work with your own tool so please bring your toolbox, if you have one, filled with your favorite tools such as:

- -paper and pen for note taking and sketching out designs
- -Earplugs (It can get really noisy!)
- -assorted pliers
- -any sort of forging hammer, mid weight
- -good cutters
- -saw frame and blades
- -assorted files
- -sanding/polishing/finishing supplies you prefer

The forging project for this class will not require soldering but in the event that you would like to solder on your piece, consider bringing your soldering materials such as:

- -solder: hard, medium, easy
- -soldering pick
- -handy flux
- -soldering tweezers
