#2 cut triangle file or square file

#2 cut crossing file or round file

#4 cut barrette

#4 cut crossing

#4 cut round

#4 cut joint (optional)

**Half Round Hand file**, #2 or #4 cut

Half round / flat forming pliers

Chain nose pliers

Parallel jaw pliers

Flat pliers

**Saw frame and blades**

The materials kit contains 16 gauge round sterling silver wire

3 preformed rings to make the upper and lower bearings and a bail

wire for the prongs
