Studio-appropriate attire:

- Closed-toe shoes
- No loose/dangling clothing or accessories
- Hair tied back

Basic Supplies:

- Pens & pencils
- Notebook & sketch paper
- Dust mask / N95

Class Supplies:

- Heavy Wall Tubing for the tube-setting (needs to be half a millimeter wider than the stone in question). Most tubing is in silver but if you can find copper tubing the right size, that will work just as well.
- Wire for making the jump rings (gauge depending on aesthetic preference). Should be the same type of metal as the final piece since it will be connecting the links.
- Stones to set in the tubes (half a millimeter smaller than the tube). CZs are what I would recommend to start with but feel free to bring whatever faceted stones you have that are the right size. You'll need enough stones to have one per link.
- Metal for casting. Silver or bronze is recommended.
- (Sample photos were made with 5.5mm tube, 5mm stones and 18 gauge wire.)
